


Naruto Whirlpool cruise

The whirling tides of Naruto strait roughly happen every 6 hours due to the ebb and the narrow strait. When the tide flows from the high sea to the low sea, it becomes a rolling rapid where the speed of the tidal current is 30 km per hour, and the size of the whirlpool is so large that its diameter sometimes touches 30 m. The sightseeing ship which departs every day at fixed times is typical of Awaji Island tourism. On a ship, you can see these dynamic whirlpools closely.


